

**COUNT ONE:**

The Grand Jurors of the County of Lamar, State aforesaid, duly organized as such at the January Term, A.D., 2005, of the District Court of the Sixth Judicial District for said County, upon their oaths in said Court present that **RUFUS WARD, JR.**, hereinafter described as defendant on or about the 13th day of December, in the year of, Two Thousand and Four in the County of Lamar and State of Texas, anterior to the presentment of this Indictment, did then and there, as a public servant, namely Red River County Commissioner, and with intent to obtain a benefit for himself or with intent to harm and defraud Red River County, Texas, did then and there intentionally or knowingly misuse government property or services or personnel, belonging to the government, namely Red River County by removing two oil storage tanks, having a Red River County Precinct Number 1 employee or employees mow a privately owned oil well site and/or dig an oil drainage pit and/or mow the defendants private pasture with a county tractor and/or mower, and having county purchased tires put on his personal pickup that had come into defendant's possession or custody by virtue of his office or employment, and the value of the misused thing was more than \$500.00 but less than \$1500.00
